OVERSIGHT BOARD TO HOLD SECOND LISTENING SESSION ON FISCAL MEASURES

Invites stakeholders to participate as part of Fiscal Plan revision process

(San Juan, PR – November 27, 2017) – The Financial Oversight and Management Board for Puerto Rico (the “Oversight Board”) created under the bipartisan Puerto Rico Oversight, Management and Economic Stability Act (“PROMESA” or the “Act”) will hold the second of three Listening Sessions on Thursday, November 30, 2017 at the Automobile Accident Compensation Administration (ACAA, for its Spanish acronym) building located on #249 Avenida Arterial Hostos, on the corner of Chardón Avenue in San Juan, starting at 9:00 a.m. These Listening Sessions with stakeholders are part of the Fiscal Plan revision process that will take place to temper the Fiscal Plan to Puerto Rico’s reality in the aftermath of Hurricane Maria. The revision process was announced during the Board’s 10th public meeting held on October 31st.

The Oversight Board will dedicate the entire session to receive testimony from experts and stakeholders representing different sectors about the magnitude, structure and timing of fiscal changes in the aftermath of Hurricane María.

The Listening Session will be open to the public and requires pre-registration by Wednesday, November 29, 2017 at 5 p.m. at the Board’s website: www.oversightboard.pr.gov. In addition, the Board encourages individuals and organizations interested in sharing their testimony regarding the subjects to be discussed

during the session to request a turn to do so by clicking “testify” on the Attendance Type dropdown menu upon registration at the Board’s website. Speaking turns are limited and will be granted on a first come, first served basis. The Board also invites individuals and organizations interested in submitting written testimony on the subjects to be discussed during the Listening Session to do so by sending their comments to the Board’s email comments@oversightboard.pr.gov by Wednesday, November 29, 2017 at 5 p.m. All testimonies received by the Board will be available on its website shortly after the deadline, unless confidentiality is requested.

The session will stream live via the Board’s website. The audio will be available in both English and Spanish. The recorded session will be posted at the website as soon as possible after the meeting.

The Oversight Board will hold one additional Listening Session on December 4, 2017 in New York City on the subjects of capital investment, labor reform and recovery funding.
